However, at age 21, Daylin put Elvis on the back-burner and joined a country rock band. Fortunately Elvis had not “left the building” for long! By 1997, Daylin had given up a career as a successful businessman to form *Erigus Productions* and produce the “Elvis for Good” show.

Before long Daylin was named the “1997 Canadian National Elvis Tribute Artist Grand Champion” and went on to perform all over Canada, the United States and in countries overseas, including Japan, Germany, Spain, and Portugal!
